Topic: The problem of goodness in moral philosophy.

This issue is a continuation of the previous issue, no. 13, which resulted from the research conducted during the First Conference of the ESMP. We chose to go more deeply into the theme of the Conference by dedicating another issue to the problem of goodness in moral philosophy.

So, starting from the question “What is good?” authors are invited to develop a reflection, in light of the following themes:

1. **The Problem of Good in the History of Philosophy** (how the meaning of “the good” has changed over the course of the history of philosophy.);
2. **The Good and Rights** (contributions that focus on the relationship between what is good and the law.);
3. **The Good in Cultures and Traditions** (contributions that highlight how the concept of the good may differ in various historical and cultural contexts.);
4. **The Good and God** (contributions that focus on the relationship between philosophical notions of the good on the one hand and belief on the other.)
